The candidates have been categorized into the following two lists:

1. List-I — Candidates Eligible for Further Consideration

This list contains candidates who are eligible for further consideration for admission, subject to verification of their academic record and other admission requirements.

Such candidates are required to carefully check their particulars and academic record. In case of any error, omission, or discrepancy, they must report to the Administration Office, University Law College, Quetta, **on or before 3rd August 2026** for necessary correction.

2. List-II — Candidates with Missing Documents / Requirements

This list contains candidates who are currently not eligible for further consideration due to non-submission of the Law Admission Test (LAT) result/certificate and/or other required documents.

Such candidates are required to submit their **missing documents on or before 3rd August 2026** to the Administration Office, University Law College, Quetta. Their status will be reconsidered after submission and verification of the required documents.

IMPORTANT

Candidates are advised to carefully examine their respective lists and complete the required corrections or submission of documents within the prescribed deadline.

The publication of these lists does not constitute an offer of admission and should not be considered as a merit list. The final merit list will be announced separately after completion of the verification and scrutiny process.

Failure to report discrepancies or submit the required documents within the stipulated time may result in the candidate being excluded from further consideration for admission.
